What is a Notary?

The notary profession dates back to Roman times and remains today a person who has the authority to carry out specific legal procedures. Notaries draw up and certify a number of documents – such as contracts and sponsorship letters – for various businesses and individuals.

Notaries are also able to act as witnesses to the signing of documents, including powers of attorney and property papers. Often, notaries are employed to authenticate various documents so they are legally recognised abroad.

Legal verification

In order for documents to be recognised as authentic when received abroad, they have to follow strict legalisation procedures. This can include arranging an 'apostille' (legal certificate), as part of the verification.
